EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS REPORT

As 2019 draws to a close, I'd like to start by thanking each of you for the opportunity to serve as IMPI's Executive Director. This year marks my 10th year in this role, and what a year it has been!

This year saw the largest membership increase in years; we started 2019 with 145 members and finished with 200 members. We welcomed 10 new Corporate Members during 2019: TurboChef, Crescend Technologies, Wave PIA, MACOM, pinkRF, Huber & Suhner, Rogers Corporation, UNOX S.p.A., Dipolar and Multek. I'd like to recognize the efforts of my colleague, Ms. Alicia Standridge, who managed membership this year in a remarkable fashion.

The Solid State RF Energy Section of IMPI was born in early 2019. Not only did the Section welcome members of the RF Energy Alliance, but other new members from across the globe who were anxious and eager to be a part of this new technology. I commend Dr. Klaus Werner, Mr. Sanghun Lee, Mr. John Mastela, Mr. David Lester and Mr. John F. Gerling for their leadership of the Section.

The Journal of Microwave Power and Electromagnetic Energy continued to flourish under the leadership of Editorin-Chief, Dr. Juan Aguilar Garib. The Journal's Impact Factor increased to .850 (from .575 the two years prior). Submissions increased, with 2019 being the first year to top 100 submissions; this led to a decrease in acceptances, a more selective process and a higher quality publication.

IMPI's 53rd Symposium in Las Vegas, Nevada in June of 2019 welcomed 130 international attendees, including 15 exhibitors who participated in our inaugural Exhibitor's Showcase. Many thanks to Dr. Graham Brodie, Mr. Roger Williams and Dr. Ulrich Erle, who led the technical program and food science & technology program committees.

In early November, TurboChef welcomed 50 attendees for the Fall Seminar, "*The Brave New World of Microwave & RF*", which received stellar reviews on our attendee survey. IMPI also held four webinars throughout the year. I'd like to recognize the contributions of Mr. Bob Schiffmann, Dr. Vladimir Bilik, Mr. John F. Gerling for serving as our instructors; I'd also like to thank Dr. Eric Brown and Conagra Brands for sponsoring, and facilitating, our webinar series.

In 2019, we launched our new and improved website: www.impi.org that includes a Member Only Section (with *The Wave* Newsletter archive, membership directory, and more), a Calendar of Events, Student, Professional Corporate Membership pages, and many more user-friendly upgrades. We continued to roll out our Social Media presence with a focus on Facebook, LinkedIn and Twitter.

Financially, we end this year in a very healthy position. The increased membership, higher than expected attendance at our events and a more robust royalty payment from the Journal led to a carryover \$20,000K higher than this same time last year. This will allow us to continue to focus on growing the Institute's reach and relevancy in 2020.

In closing, I would be remiss if I did not thank IMPI's Board of Governors and Executive Committee for their dedication to the Institute this year. The future of IMPI is bright because of your efforts.
